Costa Rica Mission Trip

INFORMATION SHEET

- 1. **Who can go?** → Teenagers, Adults, Children (accompanied w/ a parent)
- 2. What does the cost of \$1,300 include? → Airfare, transportation in CR, meals, housing, t-shirt, & life-changing experience
- **3. Do I need a Passport?** → YES! Please be sure that you obtain your own passport.
- 4. What's our project? → VBS, Sports Camp, Painting, Building Walls, Lay Tile, etc..
- **5. When's the Registration Deadline?** → December 31, 2017 (new registrants from 12.5.17 need to pay \$1,400)
- **6. What will the housing look like?** → Mainly bunkbeds or mattresses on floors at the Nazarene Seminary or at a nearby Church
- 7. Will I need to bring bedding? → Yes. Twin-size sheets or sleeping bag, pillow, etc..
- **8. What about Toiletries?** → Yes. Towels, cloths, soaps, etc...
- **9. What about the meals?** → Most breakfasts will be at the Seminary, Sack Lunches, Dinners at partner Churches
- **10.** Is there a time difference in CR? → Yes! CR is 2 hours behind FL
- **11.** What can I expect the weather to be? → Somewhat cooler than FL & daily rain
- **12. What's the primary spoken language in CR?** → Spanish (Espanol)
- 13. **Should I bring spending money?** → Yes, there will be a snack shack available at night at the Seminary and you may want to buy souvenirs or other items
- **14. Do I need to exchange currency?** → No. Most places accept US \$\$, though their currency is in "Colones", so they do a simple conversion (\$1 = about 525 colones)
- **15.** Can I use my Cellphone in CR? → Yes, but consult your provider for Int'l rates

Other Information will be provided as it gets closer, but please see a sample daily schedule for most days & some basic Encuentro-issued guidelines

8:30am → Breakfast

9:30am → Service

11:00am → Depart for Projects

1-6:00pm → Work on Projects

6:30pm → Dinner at Churches (Night Services)

8:00pm → Depart for Seminary

→ A more complete schedule will be given later

Some Guidelines → "Blessed Are The Flexible"

- → Wear pants/skirts to Church Services (especially if you'll be on the platform)
- → No expensive clothes or jewelry -- "Don't flaunt it"
- → No swearing, fighting, alcohol, or smoking
- → Travel in at least groups of 5 (minimum 1 guy)
- → Nightly Curfew is midnight (lights out & guiet)
- \rightarrow Sleep es very importante' \leftarrow I made that up. :)
