In order to have the most fun on our quiz travel trips, the following is a list of expectations. Before each trip, please print, review, parents and teen initial, sign, and turn in.

____ **RESPECT IS KEY!**

Students should be respectful of everyone in all situations. Everyone includes everyone: chaperones, coaches, staff, peers. Respect is treating others with deep consideration, fairness, and kindness.

____ **POSITIVE SPEECH ONLY!**

Choices on language, music, videos, and games are all included. Be mindful of your tone, too.

"Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen." - Ephesians 4:29

____ **SAFETY FIRST!**

Travel in THREES at all times. Super important.

Ask if you are not sure, but DO not be caught not adhering to this expectation.

____ **PERSONAL SPACE REQUIRED!**

Wrestling, roughhousing, and couple coziness are not part of Quiz travel trips.

____ **CLEANLINESS IS A VIRTUE!**

Keep yourself and all spaces you occupy clean, even more so, better than you find them.

____ **TEAM BUILDING IS PRIORITY, SO ALL ELECTRONICS ARE LIMITED!**

There will be designated times for electronics during long travel times. However, understand that the use of electronics will be subject to adult leadership discretion.

____ **MODESTY IS ESSENTIAL!**

Modest dress is essential at all times during quiz travel trips. For Quiz Days, the dress code is **regular t-shirts and long pants** (*shorts and leggings are not pants*).
